


THE RISE IN SEA LEVEL

The expansion of water due to the increase in temperature of seas and oceans.


Melting glaciers:

What's happening in Chile?


Given its extensive coastline, Chile could be particularly affected by **rising sea levels**.








Sea level rise has a number of impacts negative effects, including the loss of natural habitats, flooding of coastal areas or the retreat of the coastline.
